KHOR Hui Yi (A Level programme) and Canadian International Matriculation Programme students **Hannah Reshma Jambunathan** and **Tan Qin Ee**, from Sunway College, as well as **Na Khai Yee**, a Year 11 student from Sunway International School were recently declared winners of the Harvard Prize Book Award.

The winners each received RM2,000, a copy of the Harvard Prize Book, an opportunity for internship at the Harvard Club of Malaysia throughout the duration of their time at Sunway College and a certificate endorsed by the Harvard Club of Malaysia.

The four winners were selected from 13 finalists who are full-time students of pre-university programmes at Sunway College, and Year 11 students of Sunway International School who have completed at least one semester of study and are continuing students. They were chosen after a stringent selection process. This included an assessment by a panel of

judges from the Harvard Club of Malaysia.

Aside from having a consistent track record for their academic achievement, the candidates also had to demonstrate exceptional contribution and engagement in community service.

Sunway Education Group senior executive director **Elizabeth Lee** in her speech, said she hoped that the prize would motivate Sunway College and International School students to aim for scholastic and personal excellence.

"You have, I'm sure, strived to do your very best and that in itself represents the true spirit of our teaching here at Sunway," she added.
